Dr. Mark Labberton

Mark Labberton is the Clifford L. Penner Presidential Chair Emeritus and Professor Emeritus of Preaching at Fuller Seminary. He was ordained in the Presbyterian Church (USA) and began what was to become three decades of pastoral ministry. Labberton has a strong history in missions, as he cofounded the Christian International Scholarship (now ScholarLeaders), he serves on the board of International Justice Mission and is Senior Fellow of The Trinity Forum. Labberton calls for the unbreakable link between worship, justice, and the Christian life. He has written numerous books, including Called: The Crisis and Promise of Following Jesus Today, The Dangerous Act of Worship, and Still Evangelical?

"God's Character, God's Mission, and The Work of God's People: Everywhere All at Once"

How does the work of the Church—God's People—flow out of the nature and the mission of God's own being? As the "body of Christ" how can we be the "hands and the feet" of God to carry out his mission and work in our lives?
