- **III.** How is preaching central to our Reformed Tradition? Does it take a higher place/priority compared to other activities in the church?
- **IV.** What information are we supposed to be proclaiming? Specifically, what is the Gospel / Good News?
- V. Quote from video "God's grace is revealed in the life, death, and resurrection of Jesus Christ." What does that mean to you?
- **VI.** "... Salvation of humankind." Does this mean one cannot be "saved" without knowing and believing in Jesus as your Lord and Savior?
- VII. What does salvation of humankind mean to you?
- VIII. Presbyterians as a covenant community...
- **IX.** Read John 3:14-21 what provides salvation?
- X. Is proclamation solely talking and teaching? What else could it include?
- **XI.** Do you ever feel like you are helping to provide the salvation of humankind? Under what circumstances? What is it you are doing or saying? Does it relate to the Beatitudes?
- XII. Have you ever thought about yourself as a partner with God?
